Power based crimes have a common denominator; they stem from violations of basic human entitlements. For this reason, they produce a state of disorientation, ambivalence and psychological distress in the victim. This workshop allows practitioners to gain a deeper understanding of the effect of power based crimes on victim from a social justice perspective. It also provides provides practitioners with techniques that allow victims regain a sense of self determination taking into consideration three basic factors of human functioning: a sense of relatedness, competency and autonomy.
